As you will be aware, your child is currently preparing for their GCSE in English Literature, which they will sit on the following dates this year:

Paper 1 Shakespeare and 19th Century Novel: Wednesday 17th May 2023 (am)

Paper 2: Modern Texts (An Inspector Calls) and Poetry: Wednesday 24th May 2023 (am)

PLEASE NOTE IF YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT ON THESE DAYS, THEY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO SIT THE EXAM AT ANOTHER TIME AND WILL NOT GAIN THIS IMPORTANT QUALIFICATION.

To provide further support to students in preparation for these crucial examinations, we have scheduled a series of **Literature Commitment Sessions**, which will run **after college on a Thursday from 2.45-3.30pm in the Main Hall.**
