



## Course Details

You will study **Psychological Approaches and Applications** which examines different ways in which psychologists explain behaviour. It also examines explanations for aggression, consumer behaviour and gender identity. You will be assessed through a 90 minute examination.

You will also study **Criminal and Forensic Psychology** which examines criminal behaviour and the application of criminal and forensic psychology. This is a coursework unit

You will study **Health Psychology** which includes topics such as mental health and ways of overcoming these. You will be assessed through a 2 hour examination.

You will also carry out a research project in the final unit which is a coursework unit.

## How will it be delivered?

The course is 50% coursework and 50% external examination.

## Entry requirements

5 GCSEs 9-4 (must include a 4 in English and Maths)

## Your next steps...

Degree Level Psychology would be an obvious progression route, but certainly not the only one. Students with this level could work in a range of careers such as:

Clinical/Educational/Occupational Psychology  
Health Careers

**Next steps – It is important that if you have a career in mind that involves studying a degree at University or a Degree Apprenticeship that you RESEARCH the entry requirements of the degree you will need to study.**

**For example if you want to study Medicine you will need to study A Level Chemistry, plus one from Biology, Maths or Physics**


