Response to the Parents' Evening Survey

We would like to thank the parents/carers who took the time to respond to the survey about Parents' Evening. We had 311 responses. 183 preferenced face-to-face evenings, whilst 128 preferenced virtual evenings. In response to this, we will have a mixture of face-to-face and virtual evenings over the course of a student's time at the College. We will include full details with specific dates for 2022/23 in September.

Uniform Expectations

You have received a leaflet with full details of our uniform expectations. Please read this carefully before buying your child's uniform for September. We are continuing the special assemblies with each year group to introduce our Behaviour Curriculum for September, which explains our clear behaviour expectations to maintain a safe, calm, orderly and supportive environment in lessons and around the site. Cross Curriculum team Leaders (CCTLS) will be posting a video on the College website outlining BE FAIR EVERYWHERE expectations which we ask you to watch with your child before they return to College in September.

Attendance Matters

The response to our letters regarding the importance of regular attendance at College has been positive and we thank you for your support in ensuring your child attends every day. In line with new DfE guidance, our governors have reviewed our Attendance Policy which can be found on the College website. From September 2022, term time holidays will not be authorised. We point out that if a public exam is missed due to a holiday, students will not receive a grade for the paper they miss and you will be charged for the cost of the exam.

We are pleased that the vast majority of students arrive to College on time and have quickly adopted the more rigorous routines at the start of the day, ready for a positive start in September. Once again, we thank you for your ongoing support with this.
