Year 7 Wimbledon trip - Expression of Interest

I am writing to inform you of a planned visit to London departing on the **10**th **July 2024** and arriving back at college on the **11**th **July 2024**. Students who have worked excellently on their knowledge organisers and who have received the most achievement points will be eligible. Student's attitude to learning and behaviour record must be good.

This visit will give your child an exciting opportunity to experience a full day at Wimbledon with Court 2 tickets. They will see professional athletes in action as well as stay overnight and go bowling on the second day.

Arrangements for the Visit

- Students will depart college at 7:30am by College minibus and travel directly to Wimbledon. Students will stay all day at the event (up to 8pm).
- They will travel in the college minibus to Hudnall Park accommodation for the evening.
- The second day they will have breakfast at the accommodation and then travel back to College, stopping around lunch time for a game of Bowling and lunch.

Payment Details

Students will need to bring spending money for food at Wimbledon and lunch on the second day. We would not expect this to exceed £30. Students may also bring extra spending money to spend in the Wimbledon shop.
