## Year 9 Odd Arts Workshop: Friday 2nd May 2025

On the morning of Friday the 2nd of May, Year 9 students (who attend mainstream Drama lessons) will be involved in a workshop delivered by Odd Arts ...

They specialise in delivering theatre-based programmes that challenge and change attitudes and behaviours and enable people to understand the world and themselves differently.

All of their work is restorative, anti-racist, trauma informed, strengths based, non-violent-communication led and considerate of the environment.

Students at Minsthorpe Community College will be involved with the hard hitting play 'Here and Now' which explores many complex societal problems relating to hateful extremism, specifically focussing on the far right and International terrorism. Workshop participants use the play to try out solutions and early intervention techniques.
