## Fieldwork: Hornsea, East Yorkshire

## **Payment Details**

The College is asking for a voluntary contribution of £15 comprised of the following cost:

• Transport costs to and from location: £15. The cost of coach hire has increased significantly, and the College is therefore subsidising the field trip for all students.

If you would like your child to go on this visit, please could you give consent and pay the non-refundable deposit of £15.00 by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May. Payments and consent can be given via the School Gateway App.

## Arrangements for the Visit

Students will depart college at **8.30am** but should aim to be here and registered by this time. Students are due to return to college at approximately **4.30pm**.

Students are advised to bring either a packed lunch or money to purchase food at the location. Students receiving Free School Meals will be catered for and your child is asked to collect this from the KS3 Canteen prior to departure on the day. Your child may wish to bring some additional money for other refreshments throughout the visit.

You should make arrangements for the collection of your child from college when we return or give them permission to walk home at this time.

The College reserves the right at all times prior to departure of the visit to review the placement of any student dependent on behaviour and attitude.
