Minsthorpe Community College Work Shadowing Project for Year 9 - FRIDAY 8th March 2024

We are proud of our extensive and inclusive Careers Programme at Minsthorpe. Introducing young people to the world of work and careers is delivered through our curriculum and responding to research findings we are broadening this programme with the Year 9 Work Shadowing Project. There is strong evidence which shows that the more engagements young people have with the world of work the more likely they are to have a good job and earn more than their peers.

The key features are as follows:

- Students shadow a family member at their place of work for a day
- Parents/Carers return the paperwork overleaf to give their permission and gather the necessary information – deadline FRIDAY 23rd FEBRUARY 2024 (students return slip to duty staff on the gate or student reception)
- Students will be briefed prior to the experience in their Learning for Life lesson. This will include a talk from Job Centre Plus about the relevance of work experience and how this introduces them to the World of Work
- Students are required to complete a diary sheet to reflect on the day (this will be provided)

If you feel that you (or a family member) are in a position to help with this project, please complete the paperwork on the reverse of this letter. It is essential that you read the information carefully. For any student to take part the attached paperwork (PARENTAL & EMPLOYER PERMISSON) will need to be completed and returned by **FRIDAY 23rd FEBRUARY 2024.**

The college has a responsibility to check that the child will be covered under the Employer's liability insurance. As the employing firms have direction and control over the students on their days work shadowing, it becomes their responsibility to ensure that their employer's liability insurance includes cover for 13–14-year-old children. The absolute minimum level of cover is £1,000,000.

There can be little doubt that the day will provide a valuable experience for our student's, and we hope you are able to support this venture. We would also take this opportunity to ask you to thank the employers on the college's behalf for accommodating students on the day. We are grateful to them and to you for your support. If you have any queries, please don't hesitate to contact either myself or Mr Dowey. Should your child be unable to find a work placement they will be required to attend school as normal on that day.
