Designer Shoes - Update

In our letter in April, we informed you that students would not be allowed to wear expensive Vivienne Westwood shoes. We have taken feedback from a number of parents, and we have changed our stance on this. The governors do not wish parents/carers to spend money on expensive designer shoes, but we will leave it to your discretion what you choose to buy. Vivienne Westwood shoes are not banned.

Borrowing items of uniform

We are always happy to lend clean uniform to students if they occasionally forget items. Unfortunately, we have noted that students are not returning borrowed uniform, and this is costing the College thousands of pounds each year. This is not acceptable. In a bid to address this, from September students who borrow uniform will be required to hand in their mobile phone as a 'deposit'. This will be stored safely and returned to the student at the end of the day, when the uniform item is returned. If a student says that they do not have a phone, they will be 'wanded' to check. If a student cannot or will not leave a mobile phone as a 'deposit', they will work in isolation.
