P16 A level Geography/Biology Fieldtrips - 26th June and 13th July 2026

I am writing to inform you of an intended visit to **Fraisthorpe Beach/Flamborough Head on 26th June** and **Hornsea/Mappleton Beach on 13th July**. The trips are a compulsory requirement of your child's A level course. There is no charge for the trip as we will be taking the school minibus.

If you would like your son or daughter to go on this visit please could you give consent via the School Gateway App/sending a message into college by Friday 19th June.

Arrangements for the Visit

Students will depart college at 08.30am sharp on both days and are due to return to college at no later than 17:00pm.

During the days your child will be practising sampling methods and conducting a range of fieldwork techniques using specialist equipment. They will be working in small groups under the supervision of staff. The fieldwork will involve going into shallow water so a change of clothes/footwear will be required. Further details about the trip will be communicated to your child by their class teacher.

Students are advised to bring a packed lunch as there may not be an opportunity to buy food at Flamborough, however, at Hornsea, there will be an opportunity to do so. Students receiving Free School Meals will be catered for and your child is asked to collect this from the KS3 Canteen prior to departure on the day. Your son or daughter may wish to bring some additional money for other refreshments throughout the visit.

At all times prior to the departure of the trip, the College reserves the right to review the placement of any student dependent upon their behaviour, attendance and health.

You should make arrangements for the collection of your child from college or give them permission to walk home at this time.
