


Uniform Expectations

You have received a copy of our uniform expectations for this academic year. Please read it carefully.

This presentation covers the details of what you can and cannot wear.



Blazers - Sleeves should NOT be rolled up. Fitted blazers are not allowed. Blazers must be formal, black and have the College badge sewn on. Blazers must be worn at all times, unless staff give permission to remove them.

Jumpers /cardigans (optional) - If worn, this must be a plain black design (without logos) worn underneath the blazer

Students must not wear jackets/ hoodies/ coats instead of a blazer or a plain black jumper.











Trousers - Trousers must be full length plain black, smart with a zip and button fastening at the waistband. Proper trousers only, i.e. jeans, jeggings, leggings and cropped trousers are NOT

allowed.







Skirts (optional) -They must be a branded Minsthorpe skirt. The logo must be visible & waistband must not be rolled over.



Shirts/blouses - Shirts should have a stiff collar. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Top buttons must be fastened & ties clipped on.





Footwear - Shoes/short ankle boots must be black. If you wear lace up boots, the laces must be covered by your trousers, therefore, your trousers need to be wide enough to cover them.

Skin tight trousers with lace up boots will not be allowed.

No trainers/pumps or canvas shoes.

No heels.













Ties

A College tie in the appropriate colour must be worn at all times

Year Group Ties 2023/24

Year 7 – maroon Year 10 – gold

Year 8 – dark blue Year 11 – sky blue

Year 9 – green

Outdoor Wear

A coat or hoodie may be worn over the blazer outside of lessons.

Students must take down their hood on the school site. A woollen hat may be worn outside in cold weather.





Hair - Hairstyles should be a sensible style and suitable for the formal setting of school. No extreme hairstyles such as Mohican, sharply contrasting skin fades or undercuts.





Hair - Hair should be a sensible style and suitable for the formal setting of school with colour of natural tones and shades, similar to the student's normal hair colour. No brightly coloured hair, unnatural tones or sharply contrasting colours. You can wear plain, subtle hair band.



Jewellery - Students may wear a wristwatch (although this will need to be removed in GCSE examinations). They may also wear one small pair of gold, silver or diamante studs in the ear lobes. Earrings MUST be removed for PE. No other ear or body piercings, including nose studs, or other jewellery are allowed. They will be confiscated.







Eyelashes - No eyelash extensions of any kind are permitted.





Nails - Need to be of a reasonable length, slightly over the end of your finger tips at most. False nails/tips are banned as they are unsafe and impractical. Gel and nail polish are allowed.





Make up - Students may wear makeup of a reasonable/modest nature.





Fake Tan – Must be of a reasonable and natural nature.





PE Kit

Navy polo shirt with Minsthorpe Logo

Navy shorts with Minsthorpe Logo

Sports trainers and sports socks

Suitable footwear for activities on grass

Shin pads are recommended

Optional navy blue tracksuit bottoms or leggings with Minsthorpe Logo

Optional navy blue hoodie with Minsthorpe logo

Extra plain Navy/black layers can be worn underneath Minsthorpe PE shorts

- YOUR TEACHER will provide a spare clean kit to wear for that lesson.




Students who refuse to wear clean kit will be placed in the Removal Room for their PE lesson and sanctioned with a detention.



All equipment must be brought everyday













Important Key Messages to Note

Students who cannot wear the correct uniform for medical reasons (short term) must supply medical evidence.

College will lend clean uniform items to students, if necessary. If a student refuses to wear the supplied items, they will work in the removal room for the full day, including SB2.

The College maintains the right to make decisions about the suitability of clothing, hairstyles and makeup. If in any doubt, please check with the Cross Curriculum Team Leader BEFORE making purchases/changes to hairstyles etc.

<u>Students will not go into mainstream lessons until they have the correct uniform/hair.</u>
Students will have ONE school day in the removal room. They will then have to stay at home until resolved.

Students who refuse to borrow clean uniform provided by the college will be placed in the removal room.

Students will need to leave their phone as a deposit in the uniform room for the day to loan any item of uniform.


Incorrect uniform e.g. hair colour/style, jewellery, false eyelashes, false nails

If the issue cannot be/refusal to be resolved, home informed student will work in isolation all day (sent home unauthorised if refuses isolation)

Students will not be able to return to mainstream lessons until issues are rectified in line with the uniform policy

Students will spend ONE day in isolation and then have to stay home if not rectified



Repeat offenders will be sanctioned with SB2 detentions
