Computer Science	<p>Students will use Seneca Learning to complete quizzes that will be set every 2 weeks. They are set around 4-6 quizzes based on the lesson content from the previous 2 weeks. Students who achieve 100% will be put into a prize draw for an Amazon voucher at the end of every term.</p> <p>A revision guide can also be purchased from Student Gateway for £5.00. We encourage all students to buy one in Y11.</p>
French	<p>In order to revise, French students should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete their home learning PLUS extra optional tasks on www.languagenut.com • Complete vocab/verb home learning on Satchel One and submit evidence of how they have been learning vocabulary/verbs. • Complete independent exam skills practice e.g. reading and listening skills using https://yourlanguagelearning.co.uk/ • Complete as many past papers as they can using GCSE French 8658 Assessment Resources AQA (although these are for the previous GCSE specification, these will be useful practice for students in preparation for the new GCSE specification). • Revise regularly for their French speaking test (25% of their final GCSE and will take place in April 2026).
Religious Studies	<p>Students follow the Edexcel Religious Studies B course. The options they study within that are Paper 1; Religion & Ethics – Christianity and Paper 2; Religion, Peace & Conflict – Islam</p> <p>All students are provided with a spiral bound revision book for both papers which covers all the content needed for both exams.</p> <p>Revision materials are also placed on satchel one.</p> <p>GCSE Bitesize is also a useful resource for exploring extra information on relevant topics https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/examspecs/zm9pd6f</p>
