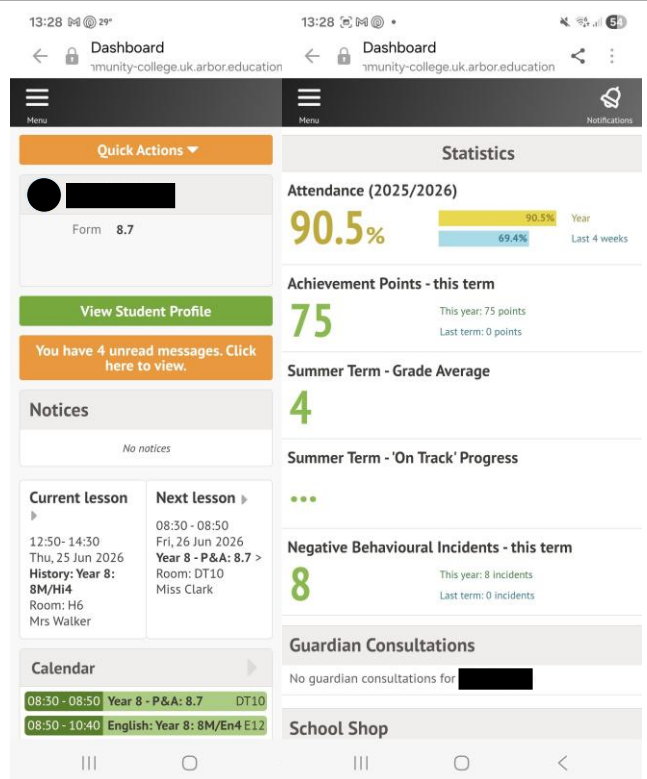


Arbor App – Parent Guide

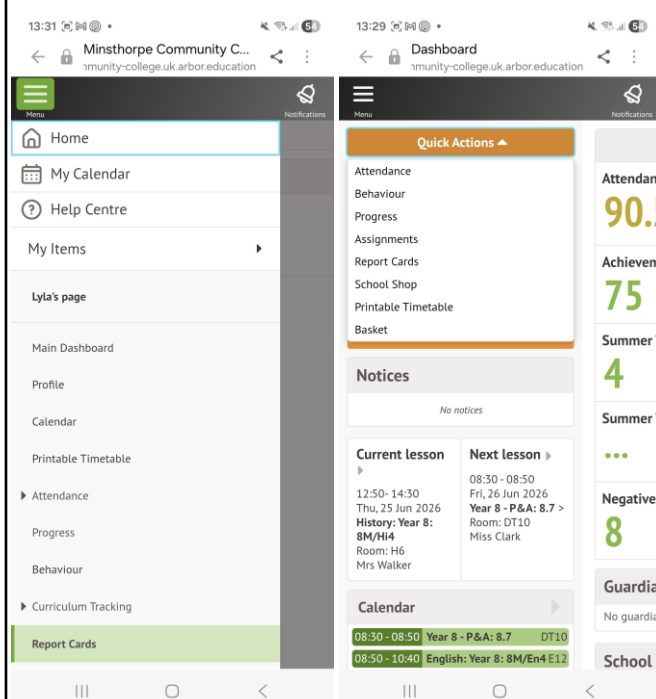
The home screen shows a wide range of data such as student name & P&A, timetable, notices, attendance and behaviour statistics.

By clicking on the 3 white lines at the top left, you can access the navigation menu.



The menu allows you to navigate to many of the different sections that were previously referred to.

There is also a 'Quick Actions' button on the homepage which allows you to quickly navigate to any of these pages.

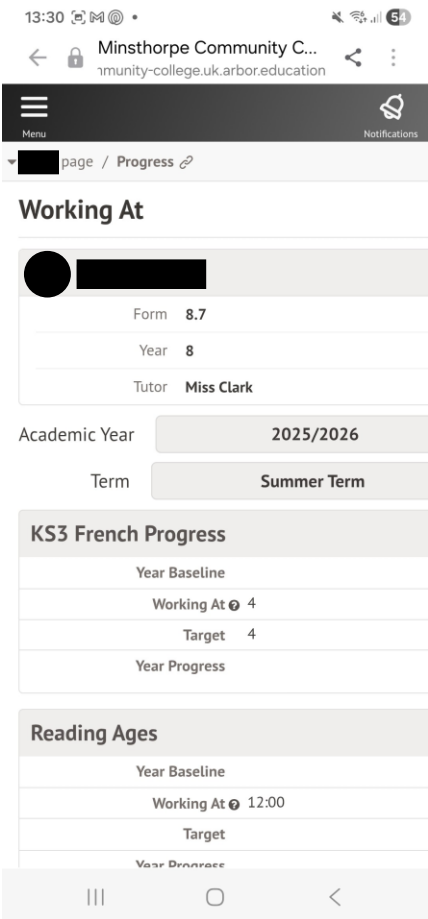


Progress

There will be a range of progress grades from different curriculum areas along with your child’s target grade.

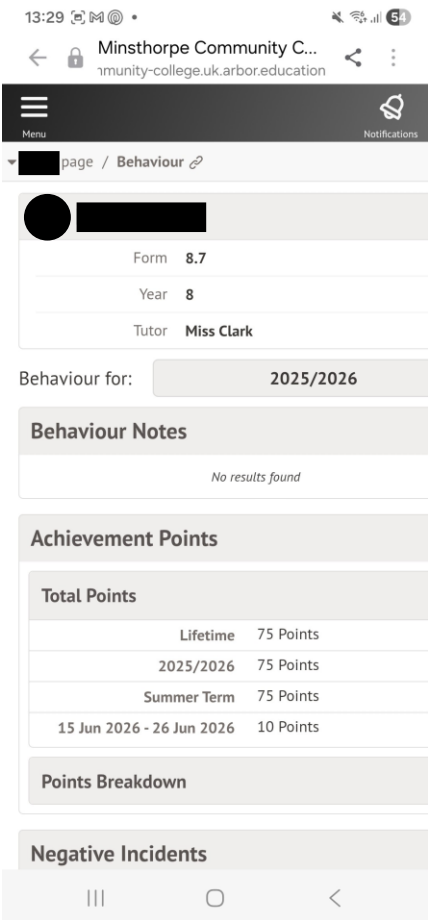
You can also view their reading age here.

The behaviour page will display any positive and negative behaviour incidents.

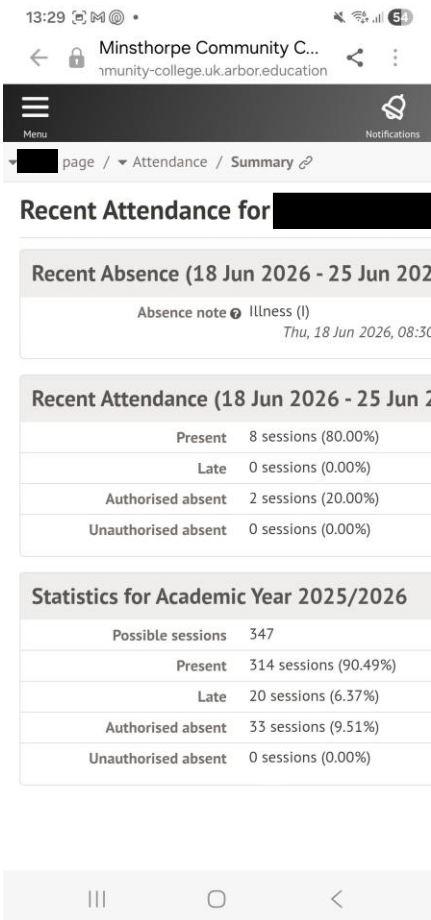
It is broken down into total time, academic year and the current term.
