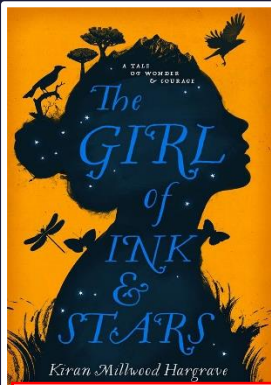

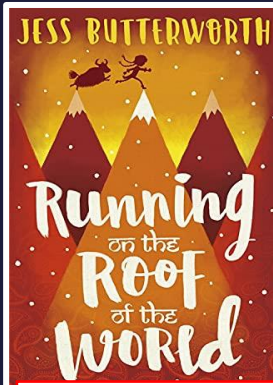

Reading age: 9+

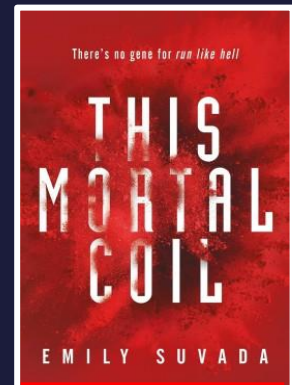
