Computer Science	<p>Students have their own Smart revise account. https://smartrevise.online/ The teacher sets them specific work each week on this, but they can also revise their own topics as well. There is an indicator on the map that tracks their weak areas. Students can purchase a revision guide and a knowledge organiser/retriever.</p>
French	<p>In order to revise, French students should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revise regularly for their French speaking test (25% of their final GCSE and will take place in April 2024). • Revise topic specific vocabulary using www.memrise.com. They should aim to achieve at least 5000+ points per week. • Complete as many past papers as they can: https://www.aqa.org.uk/subjects/languages/gcse/french-8658/assessment-resources • Complete vocab/verb home learning on Satchel One and submit evidence of how they have been learning vocabulary/verbs. • Complete independent exam skills practice as directed by their French teacher e.g. reading and listening skills using https://yourlanguagelearning.co.uk/
Religious Studies	<p>Students follow the Edexcel Religious Studies B course.
